When asked why she said yes to this program, she replied “I was encouraged to make my yes to JG1 after I spent more and more time at Newman. The Very Reverend Denis Robinson, OSB, is President-Rector of Saint Meinrad Seminary and School of Theology in St. Meinrad, IN and has served in this capacity since 2008.

A Benedictine monk, he is also an assistant professor of systematic theology. A Mississippi native, Father Denis attended Saint Meinrad College and School of Theology, earning a bachelor's degree in philosophy in 1989 and a Master of Divinity in 1993. From 1993-96, he was parochial vicar for the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Memphis, TN. He joined the Saint Meinrad monastery in August 1996.

Lenten Regulations on Abstinence and Fasting

- **Abstinence** from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years and older on Ash Wednesday and on all Fridays of Lent.
- **Fasting** is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics age 18-59. On these two days only one full meal is permitted. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each person's needs, but together should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed.
- **Health Concerns:** When health or the ability to work would be seriously affected, the obligation of the law can be modified. Such situations would include pregnant women and people with dietary needs and concerns such as diabetes.



Human trafficking is modern-day slavery.

With 21 million victims worldwide, there are more slaves today than at any time in history. Our Catholic faith calls on us to defend life and human dignity, to fight conditions that lead to the enslavement of human beings.

Answering the Gospel's call to care for those who are suffering, Led by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, we're pressing governments to strengthen and enforce anti-trafficking laws. We're raising awareness and educating people about human trafficking. And we're helping men, women and children reclaim their lives.

Please urge our elected leaders to oppose the Administration's proposed cuts to foreign aid. It's only 1% of our nation's budget, yet it does a world of good. The cuts would eliminate the Department of Labor's International Labor Bureau account, which funds programs that combat human trafficking.
