## The Day of Prayer for Life

The Day of Prayer for Life will be held Wednesday, June 30, at St Francis Church in Teutopolis. Please come and pray for renewed respect for all human life, and in reparation for our nation allowing 62 million pre-born human lives to be ended by abortion since 1973.

The Day of Prayer will begin with Mass at 8:00 AM, followed by Eucharistic Exposition and Prayer by area churches and organizations throughout the day, with Benediction at 7:00 PM, and closing Mass at 7:30 PM. A reception with refreshments will follow in St Clare Hall, adjoining the church.

Our guest celebrant for the 7:30 PM closing Mass will be Father James Flach, retired priest of the diocese of Springfield, IL, and Chaplain and Vice-President of Effingham Area Right to Life.

As we were praying together at the Memorial Day Mass at St. Charles, I was praying for all those who have passed this last year: Linda, Anne, Jane, John, Russ, Karen, Phyllis, Mildred, Winola, Mary, Tim, and Jeff. And these are the ones I know. My heart was a bit heavy, and then I remembered something.

When I was a much younger man my brother, Roger, my cousin, Sherry and myself were sitting in my Grandma's bedroom. We were getting away from the noise of a large family gathering. As we sat there, my brother picked up an index card on my Grandma's night stand. He read it aloud: *I want to be buried in my red dress with my white rosary.* Signed, *Irma Svoboda*. That was all that was on the card. We were silent for a moment, and then we laughed, not because we thought it was funny, but to break the tension. All these years later I think how free my Grandma was in being able to give those simple instructions in case she did not wake up one morning.

And then I began to think how free all those who have passed this year are as they enter into their heavenly reward. Their sojourn has ended. We are still united with them as part of the mystical body of Christ and as we come forward to make our AMEN, we become one with them as we receive the Body of Christ, and as we become the Body of Christ.


