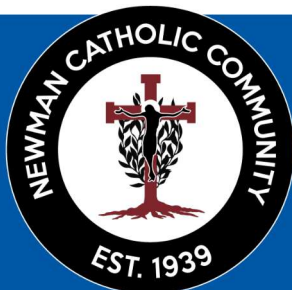

This is Our Time

Have you ever gone to the local AMC movie theater thirty minutes after a movie starts? Have you ever left an amazing movie 45 minutes into the film and then come back to see the credits? Have you ever waited an hour and then went into the movie and then left 20 minutes later?

The answer is “I do think so,” or “why would I?”

This week we, as church are invited into one of the greatest dramas: *the Sacred Triduum*. It begins on Thursday evening with the Mass of the Lord's Supper, continues with the Lord's Passion on Good Friday, and ends with our Alleluias on Holy Saturday night into Easter Sunday morning. Come experience the realities of homelessness.

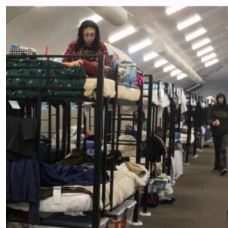

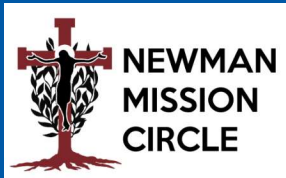
