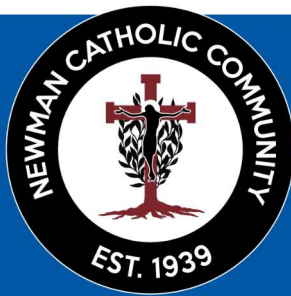

- **Graduating Seniors and Graduate Students:** *Thursday, May 2nd at 5 pm* is our Baccalaureate Mass and reception for you, family, and friends here at the Newman Center. **Everyone** is welcome to come celebrate these young men and women as they finish their time here at EIU. Let us give thanks to God for their wonderful accomplishment.



24/7 Study Zone. The space is waiting for you! Starting today, Sunday, April 28th following Phil's Pancake Palace until Thursday, May 2nd the Newman Center becomes a 24/7 study zone. We will have exam snacks and quiet places to study, along with a chapel to seek some quiet with the Lord.

- **Adopt a Bed.** Last Sunday it seems no one read the bulletin, because there are still 10 garden beds looking for a friend or family to "adopt them" for the summer. Like our friend Roy pictured here, we need folks/families who will be here this summer to care for one of our eleven beds that grace the grounds. No money needed just your time to weed. Newman will supply mulch as needed. Talk with the guy in the picture if interested.



- **Summer Storage Space Ready.** Students sometimes seek a space to leave items over the summer. Newman will once again provide space in the basement *free of charge* for students to store items they do not want to take home during summer break. You can begin bringing items on Tuesday, April 30th. You must text or talk with Roy or Doris so you can be assigned an area. There should be enough space for 10-15 students to store things.
- **Change in Mass schedule, Sacrament of Reconciliation and Adoration.** After exam week we will be reducing the number of Masses and times of Confession and Adoration for the summer. *Beginning Sunday, May 5th* we will offer the *11 am Mass only*. During the week, beginning the week of May 5th *only Tuesday Mass at 5 pm* will be offered. *Sacrament of Reconciliation* will only be offered on *Tuesdays: 3:30-4:30 pm* and *Adoration* will only be offered on *Wednesdays from 8-9 pm*. Please plan accordingly. Reminder: the chapel and grotto are open 24/7 for personal prayer and reflection.
