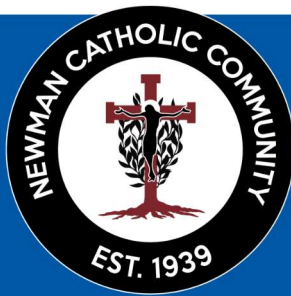

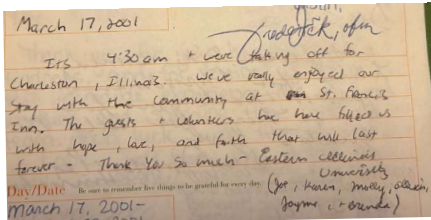


A View from My Window

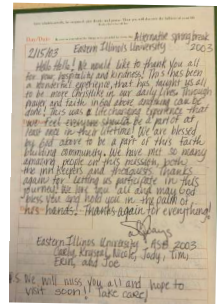
Over spring break I had the opportunity to travel with 8 others from the Newman Community to Philadelphia to volunteer at St. Francis Inn.

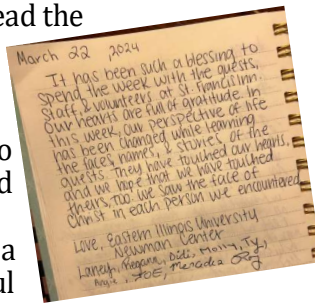
One thing that struck me was the beautiful connection EIU Newman
